What should my child know by the end of Kindergarten?

Listening

1. Follow 1 to 2 simple directions.
2. Listen to and understand stories read aloud.
3. Understand a simple conversation.

Speaking

1. Answer simple yes/ no questions.
2. Retell a story.
3. Start a conversation.
4. Be understood by others.

Reading

1. Know how a book works.
2. Understand that spoken words are made up of sounds.
3. Identify words that rhyme.
4. Identify upper and lower case letters.
5. Imitate reading by talking about pictures in a book.

Writing

1. Print own name (first and last)
2. Draw a picture that tells a story.
3. Write upper and lowercase letters.
